

## ***Little Bear East Ice Arena Guidelines and Precautions***

A mask must be worn to enter our facility.

All patrons will be asked to enter through the main lobby entrance, check in at either the office or the registration table, and exit out of the arena doors.

Please adhere to the directional signage and remember to social distance with anyone outside of your direct family.

It is our priority to keep our facility as safe as possible and you are a part of that. Please help us keep it clean and respect your neighbors' space and needs.

Total capacity for the arena is currently capped at 160 people.

### **Open Skate and Stick & Puck**

The prices for open skate are as follows:

One time: \$5.00, Month: \$20.00, Season: \$80.00

When coming in for open skate please check in at the office, so we can get you signed in. We will have to limit how many people are allowed on the ice at one time.

### **Ice Time Rental**

For games and parties locker rooms can be requested with limited capacity, but showers are closed at this time.

If more than two teams are playing during a day, locker rooms will remain closed.

### **Tournaments**

The coach or team manager for each team are asked to enter the lobby to grab a clipboard to sign in their team ahead of the time they are set to enter for their game. They will also return the clipboard prior to entrance.

There will be 16 stickers per team due at registration.

Spectators are limited to two attendees per player.

The team manager must provide a list of all parents coming to the game. Please include this list during registration.

Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the arena and in the lobby.

Concession stands will be closed, but vending machines are available. Please limit the drinks that you bring into the facility to closeable drinks such as Gatorade and water.

Players must enter the facility in their gear, besides their skates, helmets, & gloves.

Once your team is entering the facility they will go straight to the designated chairs or benches by the player benches to change into their skates quickly before they enter the ice.

Once done with the game the team will go to the same benches to remove their skates and are asked to quickly leave the facility to leave time for the next team to prepare for their game. Our changeovers between games are of limited time and in order to allow us to bring spectators for the games we must have the teams and parents leave as quickly as possible, so that we can stay on schedule.

If you have any questions about the upcoming times you will be playing the coach or team manager may enter the facility to ask any questions or look at the score board to fill their team in.
